Current Detection with a Allegro ACS756 on an ATmega328

This question is **Assumed Answered**.

I'm trying to find the easiest and intrusive way to detect current on a doorbell line, so I picked up a couple of these Allegro Microsystems ACS756KCA-PFF-T linear current sensors. INITIATE DEEPER DISCUSSIONS there. I connected the output of the sample circuit to an ADC pin on my AVK MCO according to the way the sample schematic is shown in the datasheet for doing so. I connected a 24VAC lkea lighting transformer with a little halogen bulb to the AC pins on the IC. When the light was off, the ADC reported a value that hovered around 500ish. When I turned on the bulb, it **might** have climbed to 520, but usually didn't do much of anything. I tried a couple of the ICs, but got identical results. If I put a neodymium magnet next to it, I could get a change, so it seems the Hall effect part of it was functioning to some degree.

Mawburn is that member. Always polite, always helpful and quite busy in all the areas.


Congratulations, mawburn. It is great to have you around.


